The Children's Place Retail Stores, Inc. (the "Company") was unable to file its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended April 30, 2005 (the "First Quarter 2005 Form 10-Q") on June 9, 2005 due to errors the Company discovered in its 2004 Form

10-K while preparing the financial statements for its First Quarter 2005 Form 10-Q. The Company is currently preparing an amendment to its 2004 Form 10-K to correct these errors. Because the Company's First Quarter 2005 Form 10-Q will include financial information derived from the audited financial statements included in the 2004 Form 10-K, the Company cannot file its First Quarter 2005 Form 10-Q until it files an amendment to its 2004 Form 10-K. This delay could not be eliminated by the Company without unreasonable effort and expense. The Company believes that it will be able to complete and file the 2005 Form 10-Q by the fifth calendar day following the prescribed due date.

It should be noted that the Company is currently evaluating whether the discovery of these errors has any impact on the conclusions stated in the initial 2004 Form 10-K regarding the effectiveness of the Company's disclosure controls and procedures and its internal controls over financial reporting.
